

# CDF Wagon Train

## Policies and Procedures

Updated May 26, 2005

### I. Membership

- A. There will be no "Associate" (non-CDF) members of the CDF Wagon Train. [1992]
- B. The roster will be published for distribution to members. Only the names of members whose dues are current will be published. [2000]
- C. Members whose dues are in arrears will be printed in the Fall issue of the Wagon Tongue. If not brought current by the following Annual Meeting, they will be deleted from membership. [2005]
- D. The cost of having a roster mailed to a member will be determined by the Board before each annual meeting. There is no charge for having it e-mailed. Cost for 2005-6 is \$1. [2005]
- E. There will be an Initiation Fee of \$5 for new members, in addition to the first year's dues. A member is one who has never been a member of the Wagon Train or one who has been dropped from the roster for non-payment of dues. [2005]
- F Upon receipt of a New Member Application, the Secretary/Treasurer will mail a New Member Packet which will include: a Letter of Welcome with information on obtaining member paraphernalia; Name Badge(s), a copy of the most recent issue of the Wagon Tongue; a copy of the By-law and Policies and Procedures and a current Roster. [2005]

### II. Campouts

- A. Member's dues must be current to attend campouts. [2000]
- B. Every sanctioned campout will be allotted \$50. [2001]
- C. The Wagon Master and Secretary may advance up to \$500 for campground reservations, if necessary. The amount is to be reimbursed by the attendees of the campout as part of their camp fees. [2004]

### III. Annual Meeting/Campout

- A. The Annual Meeting will convene with the "Pledge of Allegiance." [2003]
- B. The allotment for Annual Meetings shall be no more than \$500. [2005]
- C. The Wagon Train will pay copy fees for a flyer to be included in the 25-Year Club mailing with information regarding the Annual Meeting and Campout. This is to be on the reverse of the Golf Tournament flyer. [2003]
- D. When possible, there is to be a joint Wagon Train/State Golf Tournament Social held during the Annual Meeting Campout. Money will be contributed by the Golf Tournament Organizers to help pay for the cost of the bar. [2003]

### IV. Wagon Master Stipend

\$50 may be given to the Wagon Master to help defray the cost of his/her hotel stay at the 25-Year Club board Meeting, which is held each year in January. [1996]
